Cobbetts Boules Club Temporary Rules (3)

Players must at all times comply with current Government Guidelines and advice issued by Petanque England.

- Games of singles, doubles or triples are permitted as long as a distance of at least 2m is maintained between all players (except those from the same household). No physical contact, handshakes or 'elbow bumps'.
- Leave a minimum of two vacant lanes between games.
- Each player may touch only their own boules and equipment, including a jack. (So, if a jack is invalidly thrown, the other player should place his/her own jack, not pick up the original jack).
- Club equipment may not be used. This includes plastic circles, all items of furniture and scoreboards (unless substitute pegs, such as straws are used, in which case only one player from each team should touch them).
- Hands should be thoroughly washed before arrival and on return home. Equipment should be cleaned before and after use. Use hand-sanitizer and anti-bacterial spray provided, as and when necessary.
- No sharing of food/drinks/alcohol. All rubbish to be taken home.
- Any member entering the clubhouse, including the toilets, must abide by the requirements of current BSSC rules.
