Cobbetts Boules Club Temporary Rules (8)

Players must at all times comply with latest current Government and Petanque England Play Safe Guidelines.

- Every player must ensure that their attendance is logged at each event, including any non-members visiting. Any visitor playing at the club must be accompanied by a member and register contact details. Non-playing spectators not allowed at present.
- Games of singles, doubles or triples are permitted as long as a distance of at least 2m is maintained between all players (except those from the same household). No physical contact including handshakes or 'elbow bumps'.
- Leave two vacant lanes between games whenever possible. A minimum of one vacant lane must be kept at all times.
- Each player may touch only their own boules and equipment, including a jack. So, if a jack is invalidly thrown, the opposition player places his/her own jack.
- Club equipment may not be used, including plastic circles and scoreboards. Substitute pegs, such as straws, maybe used for one game only. Only one player from each team may record scores.
- Hands should be thoroughly washed before arrival and on return home. Equipment should be cleaned before and after use. Use hand-sanitizer and anti-bacterial spray provided, as and when necessary.
- No sharing of food/drinks/alcohol. All rubbish to be taken home.
- Any member entering the clubhouse, to use the toilet facilities, must abide by the requirements of current BSSC rules. Face coverings must be worn. Separation of 2m must be maintained from any other users, unless from the same household.
